- Due to the intensive nature of these courses and seminars, it is recommended you register for only one course at a time. However, it is not mandatory. You may not sign up for courses that overlap in time.
- **In order to access the internet at PUC** you will need to use your PUC email address and password. See the Education Summer School site for details.
- If you do not qualify for a tuition waiver, check the [website](#) for tuition costs.
- Failure to let Records and Education know you are dropping a class will affect your grade.
- Any material fees for classes and workshops, including the \$75 technology fee, are not covered by your conference. **Technology fees for online classes (no technology fees for hybrid or classes that have a minimal online requirement will be charged) as well as any materials fees, etc. for classes will be automatically charged to your account upon registration.** Check the schedule for information about fees for workshops and classes.
- All of the textbooks for classes are available online from the [PUC Bookstore](#) website. However, since the number of textbooks available is based on past enrollment, it is important to enroll early in order to be sure of obtaining a textbook. More textbooks will be ordered as needed, if there is enough time before class begins.
- Classroom designations that begin with ED are in the Education Department.

### **EDUC 420: GESELL TRAINING**

PUC has offered to be the host site for this training workshop. This means the Education Department **does not** sign you up for the workshop and is not involved in the content of the course. It also means this Gesell training class is **not** covered by the tuition waiver for conference employees. If you wish to take this course you must register and pay Gesell directly, rather than go through PUC. The course is \$549.00 per person for new attendees (\$449.00 for refresher course attendees within 5 years of last certification) for the 3-day workshop covering ages 2 ½ - 6 year olds; minimum enrollment for this group is 10 participants. The Older Child 6 - 9 year old training, is now a webinar plus video package that totals 8 hours over 2 days and is scheduled for Oct. 15 & 16, 2019, from 3 – 6 pm PST. Participants who want this additional training must register and pay through the Gesell website. Cost for this training is \$249.00 and you must have first completed the 3-day workshop as a pre-requisite.

Gesell Institute has the right to cancel the workshop 2 weeks prior to the June 24, 2019 start date if the minimum enrollment has not been met. However, additional registrations will be allowed up until 3 days before the workshop; participants registering late will be required to pay for rush shipping of workshop materials. Please go to [www.gesellinstitute.org](http://www.gesellinstitute.org) to register. Participants will receive a confirmation from the Institute.

If you wish academic credit for either the 3-day course and/or the older child online training, once you have registered and paid Gesell you can enroll in the EDUC 420: Gesell Training 3-day course for 1 hour of academic credit, and/or 1 hour of credit for just the online older child training (ages 6-9) if it has been less than 5 years since your 2 ½ - 6 year old training.
